However, we are in the first place, the one lying beaten and half-dead: Jesus approaches us with the "oil and wine" of the sacraments, He lifts us up on the "mount" of his cross, He takes us to the "inn" of the Church, and pays for it with the "two denarii" of the divine and human natures united in his Person. Only when we have been loved back to life in this way are we able to "go and do the same". Only in receiving God's mercy are we equipped to show it to others.
